

- S. No. 324 - An Act creating the Agricultural Insurance System of the Philippines providing funds therefor, and for other purposes.  
 Introduced by Senators Manahan and Alondras and filed on April 27, 1966;  
 Submitted to the Senate on April 27, 1966;  
 Referred to the Committee on National Enterprises on the same day;  
 Returned by said Committee with the Committee Report No. 334, recommending that it be approved without amendment on May 9, 1966;  
 Submitted said Report to the Senate on May 10, 1966;  
 (Pending for second reading).
- S. No. 325 - An Act creating the Filipino Retailers' Bank defining the powers, functions and objectives.  
 Introduced by Senator Alondras and filed on April 27, 1966;  
 Submitted to the Senate on April 27, 1966;  
 Referred to the Committee on Banks, Corporations and Franchises on the same day;  
 Re-referred to the Committee on Banks and Currencies on March 14, 1968;  
 (Pending in the Committee).
- S. No. 326 - An Act to classify and rank dental positions in government-owned or controlled hospitals and institutions at par and equally with medical positions in terms of remuneration, benefits and other privileges.  
 Introduced by Senator Ziga and filed on April 27, 1966;  
 Submitted to the Senate on April 27, 1966;  
 Referred to the Committee on Civil Service on the same day;  
 (Pending in the Committee).
- S. No. 327 - An Act providing for retirement benefits of municipal and city judges, further amending for the purpose certain Sections of Republic Act Numbered Nine hundred and ten, as amended.  
 Introduced by Sens. Diokno, Lagunbay, Liwag, Aytona, Roy, Manahan, Padilla, Tolentino and Ziga and filed on April 27, 1966;  
 Submitted to the Senate on April 28, 1966;  
 Referred to the Committee on Justice on the same day;  
 Returned by said Committee with the Committee Report No. 225, recommending that S. No. 327 be approved without amendment in consolidation with S. No. 285, on May 9, 1966;  
 Submitted said Report to the Senate on May 10, 1966;  
 Passed on second reading by the Senate without amendment on May 19, 1966;  
 Certified for immediate enactment by the President of the Philippines on May 18, 1966;  
 Passed on third reading by the Senate on May 19, 1966;  
 Sent to the House requesting concurrence on the same day;  
 House Bill No. 1766 was sent to the Senate for concurrence and in case the Senate disagreed with the said bill and insists on Senate Bill No. 327 dealing with the same subject matter, the House in anticipation asks for a conference, having appointed Cong. Ubay, Abayani and Singson as its representatives on May 17, 1967;  
 The Senate insisted on its Bill and accepted the conference asked for by the House on May 16, 1967, having appointed as conferees at the same on its part Sens. Diokno, Liwag and Sumulong;  
 Conference Report was submitted with the statement that the Conference Committee has reached an agreement on the disagreeing votes of both Houses, and agreed to by the Senate on May 17, 1967;  
 The House approved the Report of the Conference Committee on May 17, 1967;  
 (See House No. 1766 which became Republic Act No. 5085).
