

## History of Bills

- H. No. 16253 - An Act changing the name of the Northern Mindanao Institute of Technology to Iligan Institute of Technology, integrating it as a unit of the Mindanao State University, and for other purposes. Introduced by Congressman Dimaporo, Agbayni & Lucman; Submitted to the Senate on May 12, 1967; Referred to the Committee on Education on same day; Returned by said Committee with Com. Rept. No. 1498, recommending that it be approved without amendment on May 1, 1968; Submitted said Report to the Senate on May 2, 1968; Passed on second reading by the Senate with amendments May 3, 1968; Printed copies distributed to the Senators on May 4, 1968; Passed on third reading with amendments by the Senate on May 7, 1968; Amendments of the Senate sent to the House on May 8, 1968 The House agreed to the amendments of the Senate on May 14, 1968; Approved by the President of the Philippines on June 15, 1968; Converted into Republic Act No. 5363.
- H. No. 16255 - An Act creating the San Jose City. Introduced by Congressman Concepcion; Submitted to the Senate on May 16, 1968; Referred to the Committee on Prov. and Mun. Govts. and Cities on the same day; Returned by said Committee with Com. Rept. No. 1827, recommending that it be approved with amendments on February 11, 1969; Submitted said Report to the Senate on February 12, 1969; Passed on second reading by the Senate without amendments on March 24, 1969; Printed copies distributed to the Senators on same day; Approval on second reading reconsidered on March 25, 1969; Re-approved on second reading by the Senate with amendments on April 16, 1969; Printed copies distributed to the Senators on April 25, 1969; Passed on third reading with amendments by the Senate on April 28, 1969; Amendments of the Senate sent to the House on April 29, 1969; The House agreed to the amendments of the Senate on May 1, 1969;
- (1) The House in its session of May 8, 1969, reconsidered its acceptance of the amendments of the Senate to the House Bill No. 16255, and asks for the return to the House of its Message 4-E, dated May 1, 1969, as per communication from that Body dated May 8, 1969;
  - (2) The House disagreed to the amendments of the Senate to House Bill No. 16255, and asked for a conference on May 19, 1969, having appointed as representatives at the same on its part Congressman Mate, Concepcion and Loyola (S.);
  - (3) The Senate insisted on its amendments, and accepted the conference asked for by the House on May 21, 1969, having appointed as conferees at the same on its part Senators Perez, Laurel and Liwag;
  - (4) Conference Report was submitted with the statement that the Conference Committee has reached an agreement on the disagreeing votes of both Houses, and agreed to by the Senate on May 22, 1969;
  - (5) The House approved the Report of the Conference Committee on June 10, 1969; Approved by the President of the Philippines on August 4, 1969; Converted into Republic Act No. 6051.
