## AN ACT DECLARING THE LAKE HIMBANG LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TALACOGON, PROVINCE OF AGUSAN DEL SUR, AN ECOTOURISM SITE

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Lake Himbang located in the Municipality of Talacogon, Province
- 2 of Agusan del Sur, is hereby declared an ecotourism site. Pursuant thereto, its development
- 3 shall be prioritized and supported by the Department of Tourism (DOT), subject to the rules
- 4 and regulations governing the development of ecotourism sites.

1 SEC. 2. The technical description of the area to be declared an ecotourism site is as

SEC. 3. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the municipal government of Talacogon shall, in coordination with the DOT, Department of Environment and Natural Resources and concerned agencies of the government, prepare a tourism development plan that shall include the construction, installation and maintenance of such appropriate infrastructure

- and facilities to enhance tourism in the area: *Provided*, That said development plan shall ensure
- 2 the preservation and conservation of the natural beauty and resources of the area: Provided,
- 3 further, That the implementation of the tourism development plan shall be included in the
- 4 budget of the municipal government of Talacogon.
- 5 SEC. 4. The DOT shall assist the municipal government of Talacogon in the
- 6 implementation of the tourism development plan by providing technical assistance in tourism
- 7 capacity building. It shall also include the Lake Himbang in its national and regional promotion
- 8 programs.
- 9 SEC. 5. The funding for the implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual
- 10 budget of the municipal government of Talacogon. The DOT may augment such allocation
- with internally-generated funds.
- 12 SEC. 6. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the municipal
- 13 government of Talacogon shall, in consultation with the DOT and concerned agencies of the
- 14 government, promulgate rules and regulations to implement this Act.
- 15 SEC. 7. If any provision of this Act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the
- other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.
- 17 SEC. 8. All laws, rules, regulations, presidential decrees and other issuances
- 18 inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed repealed or amended
- 19 accordingly.
- SEC. 9. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
- 21 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
