AN ACT

CONVERTING THE CAMPUS OF THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES LOCATED IN THE CITY OF PARAÑAQUE, INTO A REGULAR CAMPUS OF THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES, TO BE KNOWN AS THE POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES-PARAÑAQUE CITY CAMPUS, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** This Act shall be known as the “*Polytechnic University of the*
2 *Philippines (PUP)-Parañaque City Campus Act.*”
3

4 **SEC. 2.** The campus of the PUP located in the City of Parañaque, National Capital
5 Region (NCR) is hereby converted into a regular campus of the PUP to be known as the
6 PUP-Parañaque City Campus.

8 **SEC. 3.** The PUP-Parañaque City Campus shall offer short-term, technical-
9 vocational, undergraduate, and graduate courses within its areas of competency and
10 specialization, as the Board of Regents, hereinafter referred to as the Board, may deem
11 necessary for the accomplishment of its objectives, and those which respond to the human
12 resource development needs of the City of Parañaque and the NCR.
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14 The PUP-Parañaque City Campus is also mandated to undertake research and
15 extension services, and production activities in support of the socio-economic
16 development and to provide progressive leadership in these areas.
17

18 **SEC. 4.** The PUP-Parañaque City Campus shall be headed by a Campus
19 Administrator who shall render full-time service and shall be appointed by the Board,
20 subject to the qualification standards prescribed by the Board, and based on the
21 recommendation of a search committee duly constituted for the purpose of selecting the
22 Campus Administrator.

1 **SEC. 5.** The PUP shall ensure that the minimum requirements of the Commission
2 on Higher Education (CHED) for the operation of the PUP-Parañaque City Campus,
3 including those related to its course offerings, are fully complied with.
4

5 **SEC. 6.** All assets, both real and personal, personnel, and records of the PUP-
6 Parañaque City Campus, as well as its liabilities or obligations, shall be transferred to the
7 PUP. The positions, rights, and security of tenure of faculty members and personnel
8 therein employed under existing laws prior to the conversion into a regular campus shall
9 be respected.
10

11 All parcels of land belonging to the government to be occupied by the PUP-
12 Parañaque City Campus shall be transferred to the PUP: *Provided*, That should the campus
13 or the PUP cease to exist or be abolished or should such aforementioned parcels of land
14 be no longer needed by the PUP, the same shall revert to the City of Parañaque or to the
15 Republic of the Philippines, as the case may be.
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17 **SEC. 7.** The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the
18 “Higher Education Modernization Act of 1997”, shall form part of this Act.
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20 **SEC. 8.** The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be
21 included in the annual General Appropriations Act (GAA).
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23 The City of Parañaque shall provide the same amount of financial assistance to the
24 campus until such time that the amount necessary for the continued operation and
25 maintenance of the PUP-Parañaque City Campus shall be included in the annual GAA.
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27 **SEC. 9.** Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Board shall, in
28 consultation with the CHED, issue rules and regulations to implement the provisions of
29 this Act.
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31 **SEC. 10.** If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared invalid or
32 unconstitutional, the remaining parts or provisions not affected shall remain in full force
33 and effect.
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35 **SEC. 11.** All other laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and
36 regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are repealed or
37 modified accordingly.
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39 **SEC. 12.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
40 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
