AN ACT

DECLARING THE TWIN ISLANDS OF SAN PEDRO AND SAN PABLO, LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HINUNANGAN, PROVINCE OF SOUTHERN LEYTE, AS ECOTOURISM ZONES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. The Twin Islands of San Pedro and San Pablo located in the Municipality 2 of Hinunangan, Province of Southern Leyte, are hereby declared as ecotourism zones. Pursuant 3 thereto, their development shall be prioritized and supported by the Department of Tourism 4 (DOT), subject to the rules and regulations governing the development of ecotourism zones.

SEC. 2. Within one (1) year after the approval of this Act, the municipal government 5 6 of Hinunangan shall, in coordination with the DOT, Department of Environment and Natural Resources and concerned agencies of the government, prepare a joint tourism development 7 plan for the Twin Islands of San Pedro and San Pablo that shall include the construction, 8 installation and maintenance of such appropriate infrastructure and facilities to enhance tourism 9 in the areas: Provided, That said development plan shall ensure the preservation and 10 conservation of the natural beauty and resources of the areas: Provided, further, That the 11 implementation of the tourism development plan shall be included in the budget of the 12 municipal government of Hinunangan. 13

14 SEC. 3. The DOT shall assist the municipal government of Hinunangan in the 15 implementation of the tourism development plan by providing technical assistance in tourism capacity building. It shall also include the Twin Islands of San Pedro and San Pablo in its
 national and regional promotion programs.

SEC. 4. The funding for the implementation of this Act shall be included in the annual
budget of the municipal government of Hinunangan. The DOT may augment such allocation
with internally-generated funds.

6 SEC. 5. Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the municipal 7 government of Hinunangan shall, in consultation with the DOT and concerned agencies of 8 the government, promulgate rules and regulations to implement this Act.

9 SEC. 6. If any provision of this Act shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, the 10 other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

11 SEC. 7. All laws, rules, regulations, presidential decrees and other issuances 12 inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby deemed repealed or amended 13 accordingly.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
