EXPLANATORY NOTE

The present bill seeks to create the barrios of Can-avid, Carolina, Barok, Casangaya, Mabuhay, Camantang, Canilay, Pandol and Balagon as an independent municipality to be known as municipality of Can-avid.

The group of barrios aggregate a population of no less than ten thousand souls and an income from real estates of no less than six thousand pesos per annum. The progress in education and economic condition of the inhabitants therefore, justify the creation of these barrios into an independent municipality.

The municipality of Dolores, Samar, has no less than twenty barrios and has a very extensive territory. The police work or the maintenance of peace and order will be made easier by the creation of these barrios into a separate and independent body politic. The distance from the poblacion of Dolores to the remotest barrios of Pandol and Balagon is estimated to be no less than 20 kilometers.

In view of the foregoing consideration, the undersigned respectfully requests unanimous approval of said bill.

AN ACT
CREATING THE BARRIO OF CAN-AVID AND CERTAIN BARRIOS
INTO A MUNICIPALITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 Section 1. The barrios of Can-avid, Carolina,
2 Barok, Cansangaya, Mabuhay, Camantang, Canilay, Pandol
3 and Balagon, are hereby constituted as a separate and
4 independent municipality to be known as the Municipality
5 of Can-avid.

6 Sec. 2. The municipal mayor, vice-mayor and coun-
7 cilors of the newly created municipality shall be
8 appointed by the President of the Republic of the
9 Philippines to hold office until the successors are
10 duly elected and qualified.

11 Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
