H. No. 484 - An Act providing for the creating, organization and operation of internal audit services in all Departments, Bureaus and Offices of the national government.
Introduced by Congressman Roces;
Submitted to the Senate on May 8, 1962;
Referred to the Committee on Government Reorganization on the same day;
The Senate having passed a Bill (S. No. 115), similar to this Bill, and owing to discrepancies found in the provisions of the two measures, the House asked for a conference on May 17, 1962, having designated as representatives on its part Congressmen Crisologo, Roces and Millan;
The Senate insisted on its Bill and accepted the conference asked for by the House on May 17, 1962, having appointed as conferees at the same on its part Senators Puyat, Roy and Padilla;
Conference Report was submitted with the statement that the Conference Committee has reached an agreement on the disagreeing votes of both Houses, and agreed to by the Senate on May 17, 1962;
The House approved the Report of the Conference Committee on the same day;
Approved by the President of the Philippines on June 16, 1962;
Converted into Republic Act No. 3456.

H. No. 487 - An Act providing for the establishment of a national school of arts and trades in the Municipality of Taft, Province of Samar, to be known as Samar National School of Arts and Trades, and authorizing the appropriation of funds therefor.
Introduced by Congressman Abrigo;
Submitted to the Senate on February 27, 1964;
Referred to the Committee on Education on the same day;
Returned by said Committee with the Committee Report No. 1057, recommending that it be approved with amendments on April 3, 1964;
Submitted said Report to the Senate on April 7, 1964;
Certified for immediate enactment by the President of the Philippines on May 15, 1964;
May 7, 1965;

H. No. 490 - An Act providing for the establishment of an agricultural high school in the Municipality of Tabuk, Kalinga, Mountain Province, to be known as Bibak National Agricultural High School, and authorizing the appropriation of funds therefor.
