

REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1937

Revising and codifying the Tariff and Customs Laws of the Philippines. (H No. 5513)

Introduced jointly by the Committee on Ways and Means and the Special Committee on Revision and Codification of Tariff Customs and all tax laws with report (Committee Report No. 2157) recommending its approval, April 16, 1956, PCR, p. 1296.

Referred to the Committee on Appropriations for action on the appropriation, April 16, 1956.

Immediate consideration approved unanimously, June 16, 1956.

Passed on second reading, June 16, 1956, PCR pp. 3262-3284; July 17, 1956, pp. 3286-3384.

Passed on third reading, July 17, 1956, PCR, pp. 3348-3349.

Sent to the Senate requesting concurrence, July 19, 1956.

Passed by the Senate with amendments, July 24, 1956.

Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means and the Special Committee on Revision and Codification of Tariff, Customs and all Tax Laws, July 25, 1956.

Senate recalled its amendments and asked for the return of its message, February 4, 1957.

House returned Senate amendments and its message, February 5, 1957.

Passed by the Senate with amendments, May 14, 1957.

Referred to the Committee on Ways and Means and the Special Committee on Revision and Codification of Tariff, Customs and all Tax Law, May 16, 1957.

Disagreed to the amendments of the Senate and asked a conference, May 16, 1957.

Senate insisted on its amendments and accepted the conference, May 18, 1957.

Conference report agreed to by the House, May 23, 1957.

Conference report agreed to by the Senate, May 23, 1957.

Approved by the President, June 22, 1957.
