

AN ACT CHANGING THE DATE OF ELECTIONS FOR THE **AUTONOMOUS OFFICIALS** OF THE REGION FOR MUSLIM MINDANAO, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE R.A. 7647 ENTITLED "AN ACT REGULAR DATE OF THE **PROVIDING** FOR **FOR ELECTIONS** REGIONAL GOVERNOR. REGIONAL VICE-GOVERNOR AND MEMBERS OF THE REGIONAL LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE AUTONOMOUS REGION IN MUSLIM MINDANAO AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Republic Act No. 7647 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. The regular elections for regional governor, regional vice-governor, and members of the Regional Legislative Assembly for the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, shall be held on the second Monday (after the Muslim month of Ramadhan immediately preceding the end of the term of office of such officials except the second regular election in 1993 which shall be held on the 25th of March, 1993.) OF NOVEMBER NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY SIX (1996) AND ON THE SAME DAY EVERY THREE YEARS THEREAFTER. THE REGIONAL GOVERNOR, VICE-

OF THE AND THE **MEMBERS** GOVERNOR. REGIONAL LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY-ELECT SHALL ASSUME OFFICE AT TWELVE O'CLOCK NOON ON THIRTIETH DAY OF **NOVEMBER** THE FOLLOWING THEIR ELECTION: Provided, that [if no candidate shall have been duly elected and qualified on March 31, 1993,] the incumbent regional governor, [and] THE **MEMBERS** OF THE vice-governor, AND REGIONAL LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY WHOSE TERM WILL EXPIRE ON MARCH 31, 1996 shall continue in office in a hold-over capacity until their successors shall have duly elected and qualified, subject to Article VIII, Section 11 of Republic Act No. 6734: Provided, further, That while acting in a hold-over capacity, the regional governor and vice-governor shall not disburse public funds except for personnel and administrative matters, make promotions, transfer and/or including appointments, assignments of personnel and shall be subject to all the restrictions and/or prohibitions mandated by Section 261 of the Omnibus Election Code more particularly, but not limited to, paragraphs (g); (h); (k); (m); (o); (r); (u); (v); (w); and (x). of said section."

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. Approved,
