AN ACT

DECLARING APRIL OF EVERY YEAR AS THE NATIONAL BASKETBALL MONTH

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. – This Act shall be known as the National Basketball
 Month.

SEC. 2. *Declaration of Policy.* – Article XIV, Section 19 of the Constitution provides that the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry.

8 Pursuant to the aforementioned mandate, it is incumbent upon the State to 9 support programs that will promote team sports such as basketball which is deemed to 10 be the most popular sport in the country and is therefore a significant tool in promoting 11 not only the physical, mental, and social well-being of the youth but also in teaching 12 important values and life skills such as sportsmanship, respect, responsibility, 13 communication, leadership, and teamwork.

- 1 SEC. 3. Objectives. - The objectives of this Act are the following: 2 (a) To commemorate the sport of basketball and its positive impact on Filipino 3 culture and society; 4 (b) To promote through basketball the importance of physical activity and a 5 healthy lifestyle across all ages; 6 (c) To promote basketball in the local government units and educational 7 institutions through the conduct of local and national basketball tournaments 8 as venue for talent identification, selection and recruitment of student 9 athletes: and (d) To institutionalize the annual celebration of a National Basketball Month in 10 11 all provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays. 12 SEC. 4. National Basketball Month. - The month of April of every year is hereby 13 declared as National Basketball Month. 14 SEC. 5. Program of Activities. - To ensure the meaningful observance of the 15 National Basketball Month, the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) shall, in 16 coordination with the Philippine Olympic Committee (POC), Department of Education 17 (DepEd), Commission on Higher Education (CHED), Games and Amusements Board 18 (GAB), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and concerned 19 National Sports Association (NSA), prepare and implement an annual program of 20 activities which shall include the following: 21 (a) Basketball events and activities for all ages at the local parks and community 22 centers across the country: (b) Inter-barangay basketball leagues or friendly games; 23 (c) Free basketball training, coaching, and officiating a basketball game; 24 25 (d) Exhibition or demonstration games among professional players; 26 (e) Paralympic basketball for persons with disabilities and para-athletes; (f) Women's participation in basketball; 27
- 28 (g) Viewing parties for major basketball games; and
- 29 (h) Virtual basketball sports or e-basketball sports.
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SEC. 6. Duties and Responsibilities of Concerned Government Agencies. –

- 31 The following agencies shall perform the following duties and responsibilities:
- (a) The PSC shall, in coordination with the POC, GAB, and concerned NSA,
 formulate and implement the annual program of activities for the National
 Basketball Month and ensure the continuity of its promotion and
 development;

- (b) The DepEd shall be responsible for raising awareness and promoting the
 benefits of basketball by integrating the sport in the physical education
 activities in the primary and secondary levels, encouraging the schools to
 host basketball clinics, and ensuring that school facilities and equipment are
 available to promote the sports;
- 6 (c) The CHED shall promote collegiate basketball leagues in the tertiary level, 7 especially among the athletic associations, by incorporating basketball in the 8 physical education classes, encouraging tertiary schools to host basketball 9 leagues, tournaments, inter-collegiate basketball competitions, and providing 10 the needed facilities and equipment to promote the sport;
- (d) The DILG shall direct all local government units to formulate programs to
 promote basketball within their respective localities and to coordinate,
 cooperate and support the plans, programs, and activities of concerned
 government agencies in observance of the annual celebration of the National
 Basketball Month; and
- (e) The concerned NSA shall provide technical support, including the training of
 teachers, coaches, and officiating of the game.

18 **SEC. 7.** *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* – The PSC shall, in coordination 19 with the DILG, DepEd, CHED, and concerned NSA, promulgate the rules and 20 regulations to implement the provisions of this Act within sixty (60) days after its 21 effectivity.

SEC. 8. Separability Clause. – If any part or provision of this Act is held invalid or
 unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and
 effect.

SEC. 9. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, executive orders, issuances, decrees, rules
 and regulations inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Act are deemed
 amended, modified or repealed accordingly.

SEC. 10. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
 in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
