## AN ACT

## STRENGTHENING LOCAL SPORTS PROGRAMS TO DEVELOP YOUNG ATHLETES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

**SECTION 1.** *Declaration of Policy.* – Article XIV, Section 19 (1) of the Constitution provides that the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry.

6 Pursuant to the aforementioned policy, the State shall appropriate funds for the 7 upgrade of sports facilities and extend financial assistance in the form of sports 8 vouchers to mitigate the cost of participation in a sports club, recreation club, sports 9 association, or sports organization of their choice: *Provided*, That the sports club, 10 recreation club, sports association, or sports organization is duly accredited or 11 recognized by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC). SEC. 2. *Program Funds.* – To further promote sports and its benefits among the youth, the PSC shall allocate adequate resources to financially support the affiliation of young athletes, including those with disabilities, who cannot afford to join any local sports club, recreation club, sports association or organization by reason of financial constraints. For this purpose, the PSC shall manage and administer three (3) separate funds, as follows:

- 7 (a) Get Started Fund. - The fund shall be used to assist young athletes, including those with disabilities, with a discount voucher of up to Three 8 9 thousand pesos (P3,000.00) annually to help pay for their membership, registration, participation, training, or general fees, including the purchase 10 11 of sports equipment and uniforms. The vouchers can be redeemed at any sports club, recreation club, sports association or organization that is duly 12 13 accredited or recognized by the PSC and have facilities and activities which can provide the proper, well-equipped, safe, healthy, comfortable, and 14 accessible venue, and opportunities for training and competition: Provided, 15 That the voucher providers are registered with the program. 16
- (b) Get Going Fund. The fund shall be used to support local sports clubs,
   recreation clubs, sports associations, and sports organizations with funding
   of up to Fifty thousand pesos (P50,000.00) annually for sustainability
   of existing projects and programs that promote grassroots sports
   development; and
- (c) Get Playing Fund. The fund shall provide up to Five hundred thousand
   pesos (P500,000.00) annually in order to assist local sports clubs,
   recreation clubs, sports associations, and sports organizations in improving
   sports facilities and encourage more young athletes to become actively
   involved in the sports activity of their choice.
- SEC. 3. *Eligibility Criteria.* To avail of the sports voucher, the young athlete
   must be:
- (a) Under the age of eighteen (18) and is actively engaged in any sports;
  (b) A member of any local sports club, recreation club, sports association, or
- organization duly accredited or recognized by the PSC; and
- (c) A resident in the locality where the sports club, recreation club, sports
   association or organization is located.
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**SEC.** 4. Conditions for the Use of the Voucher. – The use of the sports voucher shall be governed by the following terms and conditions:

(b) It is non-transferrable to any person except to another PSC-accredited or 2 recognized local sports club, recreation club, sports association or 3 organization: *Provided*, That the transfer can be done only once a year: 4 *Provided, further,* That the transfer must be applied prior to the actual use 5 and enjoyment of the sports facilities; 6 7 (c) It cannot be reused once redeemed by any PSC-accredited or recognized local sports club, recreation club, sports association or organization; and 8 9 (d) Only one (1) voucher shall be payable to an eligible athlete per calendar 10 year. 11 SEC. 5. Sports Vouchers Providers. - To be eligible under the program, the 12 13 sports club, recreation club, sports association or organization must be affiliated to a National Sports Association, duly recognized by the Philippine Olympic Committee 14 and the PSC. 15 16 **SEC.** 6. *Appropriations*. – The initial amount necessary for the implementation 17 of this Act shall be charged against the current year's appropriations of the PSC. Thereafter, such amount shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. 18 SEC. 7. Implementing Rules and Regulations. - The PSC shall, in consultation 19 20 with various national sports associations, promulgate the rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this Act within sixty (60) days after its effectivity. 21 22 SEC. 8. Separability Clause. – If any part or provision of this Act is held invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected shall remain in full force and 23

(a) It shall not be redeemable for cash;

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SEC. 9. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, executive orders, issuances, decrees, rules and regulations inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Act are deemed amended, modified or repealed accordingly.

SEC. 10. *Effectivity*. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
