AN ACT DECLARING THE CITY OF GENERAL SANTOS AS THE TUNA CAPITAL OF THE PHILIPPINES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1, Article XII of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State 2 shall promote industrialization and full employment based on sound agricultural development and agrarian 3 reform, through industries that make full and efficient use of human and natural resources, which are 4 competitive in both domestic and foreign markets.

Towards this end, the State recognizes the importance of the tuna industry as a driver of
development not only because of its potentials as a source of tuna products that contributed tremendously
to the country's export earnings, but for having provided livelihood to a multitude of fisherfolks and
workers of allied industries not only in the City of General Santos, but also in the rest of the country.

SEC. 2. In recognition of its status as the country's largest producer of fresh and canned tuna and
 vital contribution in making the Philippines a major player in the world tuna industry, the City of General
 Santos is hereby declared as the "Tuna Capital of the Philippines".

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after completion of its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
