Senator Padilla. I am not blaming Your Honor and I am not blaming anybody.

Senator PRIMICIAS. I know, but may I ask everybody to cooperate to the extent that if they have poor copies of the bills included in the agenda, to

send their secretaries to get the copies.

Senator PADILLA. There are extra copies. Sometimes when we do not get an amendment by substitution we can get a copy from the personnel of the Senate, but now I have requested one of my men to get a copy but even that is not available. Senator PRIMICIAS. There must be something wrong there. I ask for suspension.

Senator CUENCO. Mr. President, we request that we should be informed at least what we are voting on. It may happen that we will vote that we be hanged.

Senator PRIMICIAS. That is why being in the agenda the Secretary reads the title. That is in the Rules. Probably sometimes we do not listen to the Secretary. We must listen to the Secretary when he reads the bill so we will know what bill is being read. We cannot go around saying that this is the bill and like that.

- 2. That on page 2, line 4, insert the word ANY between the words "or" and "alkaloids", and delete the letter "s" at the end of the word "alkaloids";
- 3. That on the same page 2, line 5, insert the word ANY between the words "or" and "alkaloids" and delete the letter "s" at the end of the word "alkaloids";
- 4. That on the same page 2, line 9, delete the word "or" appearing at the beginning of the line, insert the word AMERICANA between the words "cannabis" and "satival", and then delete the words "satival, is also known as";
- 5. That on the same page 2, line 10, insert the word GUAZA between the words "bhang," and "churrus", likewise insert the word AND between the words "churrus," and "ganjah", delete the words "and under whatever" and in lieu thereof insert the following: EMBRACES EVERY KIND, CLASS AND CHARACTER OF INDIAN HEMP, WHETHER DRIED OR FRESH FLOWERING OR FRUITING TOPS OF THE PISTILLATE PLANT CAN-NABIS SATIVAL, FROM WHICH THE RESIN HAS NOT BEEN EX-TRACTED,;
- 6. That on the same page 2, line 11, delete the words "none they may be designated in commerce,";
- 7. That on the same page 2, line 12, between the words "varieties" and "and", insert the following: WHETHER USED AS REFEERS, RESIN, EXTRACT, TINCTURE OR and delete the word "and" appearing at the end of the line;

"An Act to provide for National Tax Census" Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assemblen:

SECTION 1. Every resident of the Philippines over eighteen years of age, every guardian of minors and executor or administrator of estates and every corporation joint stock company, partnership, joint account or association, whether domestic or resident foreign, shall within one hundred days from the effective date of this Act, and during the month of January of each succeeding year, file with the city or municipal treasurer in such form as the Commissioner of Internal Revenue, with the approval of the Secretary of Finance shall prescribe, without charge to such resident, corporation, joint stock company, partnership, joint account or association, a statement under oath showing: in the case of a corporation, joint stock company, partnership, joint account or association: (1) the name of the business or businesses engaged in, (2) form of organization, (3) name and nationality of President, (4) name and nationality of manager thereof and (5) list of stockholders, partners or members of associations with their respective holdings; in the case of individuals; (1) name, (2) age, (3) sex, (4) nationality (if alien, the number of the Alien Registration Certificate), and aliases used, or authorized to be used, if any, (5) address, (6) occupation, (7) place of business, (8) wife's or husband's name, age, sex, occupation and place of business, and (9) the members of his family, age and sex; and in both cases; (1) real property owned, stating the nature thereof, location and assessed value thereof, and
