

H.No. 6584.- The Anti-subversion Act;

Introduced by Congressmen Duran, Rocas, Roy, Corrus (E.J.), Cabanbang, and many others...;

Submitted to the Senate on April 25, 1957;

Referred to the Committee on National Defense and Security on the same day;

Returned by said Committee with the Committee Report No.1623, recommending that it be approved with amendments on May 10, 1957;

Submitted said Report to the Senate on the same day;

Passed on second reading by the Senate with amendments on May 22, 1957;

Certified for immediate enactment by the President of the Philippines on April 23, 1957;

Passed on third reading with amendments by the Senate on May 22, 1957;

Amendments of the Senate sent to the House on May 23, 1957;

The House disagreed to the amendments of the Senate, and asked for a conference on May 23, 1957; having designated as representatives on its part Congressmen Rocas, Roy and Benito;

The Senate insisted on its amendments, and accented the conference asked for by the House on May 23, 1957, having appointed as conferees at the same on its part Senators Pelaez, Rosales and Lim;

Conference Report was submitted with the statement that the Conference Committee has reached an agreement on the disagreeing votes of both Houses, and agreed to by the Senate on May 23, 1957;

The House approved the Report of the Conference Committee on the same day;

Approved by the President of the Philippines on June 20, 1957;

Converted into Republic Act No. 1700.
