be approved without amendment.
Passed on second reading by the Senate without amendment on
May 11, 1963;
Printed copies distributed to the Senators on May 17, 1963;
Passed on third reading by the Senate on May 20, 1963;
Sent to the House requesting concurrence on May 21, 1963;
The House having passed a Bill (H. No. 3770) similar to
this Bill, and owing to discrepancies found in the pro-
visions of the two measures, the Senate asked for a
conference on May 20, 1963, having designated as repre-
sentatives on its part Sens. Balao, De la Rosa and
Almendras;
The House insisted on its Bill and accepted the conference
asked for by the Senate on May 22, 1963, having appointed
as conferees at the same on its part Cong. Bagatsing,
Valdez and Noel;
Conference Report was submitted with the statement that the

S. No. 454 - An Act to amend further Article three hundred and thirty-
five of the Revised Penal Code. (Re: Rape)
Introduced by Sens. Fernandez and Padilla and filed on
April 19, 1963;
Submitted to the Senate on April 23, 1963;
Referred to the Committee on Revision of Laws on the same day;
Returned by said Committee with the Committee Report No. 684,
recommending that S-451 and S-454 be consolidated and
that the latter be approved without amendment and making
Sen. Lim as co-author of the bill on May 13, 1963;
Submitted said Report to the Senate on May 14, 1963;
Passed on second reading by the Senate without amendment on
May 15, 1963;
Printed copies distributed to the Senators on May 20, 1963;
Passed on third reading by the Senate on May 23, 1963;
Sent to the House requesting concurrence on the same day;
The House having passed a Bill (H. No. 5888) similar to this
Bill, and owing to discrepancies found in the provisions
of the two measures, said House asked for a conference on
May 23, 1963; having designated as representatives on its
part Cong. Albert, Balite and Macias;
The Senate insisted on its Bill and accepted the conference
asked for by the House on May 7, 1964, having appointed
as conferees at the same on its part Sens. Liwag,
Padilla and Diokno;
Conference Report was submitted with the statement that the
Conference Committee has reached an agreement on the
disagreeing votes of both Houses, and agreed to by the
Senate on May 20, 1964;
The House approved the Report of the Conference Committee on
May 21, 1964;
