AN ACT REPEALING REPUBLIC ACT NUMBERED ONE
THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED, AS AMENDED,
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ANTI-SUBVERSION ACT

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. Republic Act Numbered One Thousand Seven Hundred
2 (R.A. No. 1700) entitled "An Act To Outlaw The Communist Party Of
3 The Philippines And Similar Associations, Penalizing Membership
4 Therein, And For Other Purposes", as revived by Executive Order
5 Numbered One Hundred Sixty-Seven (E.O. No. 167 dated May 5, 1987)
6 and subsequently amended by Executive Order Numbered Two Hundred
7 Seventy-Six (E.O. No. 276 dated July 15, 1987) is hereby repealed.
8 Presidential Decree Nos. 885, 1736, 1835 and 1975 remain
9 repealed, and all laws, letters of instruction, presidential issuances,
10 orders, rules and regulations implementing said decrees are hereby
11 likewise repealed.

1 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
2 publication in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
