The PRESIDENT. What does the gentleman from Rizal say?

Senator SUMULONG, Well, I will leave it to the Senate, Mr. President.

The PRESIDENT. What does the gentleman from Misamis Oriental sav?

Senator PELÁEZ. I also submit it to the Senate. I accept it as an amendment to my amendment, but since the sponsor left it to the Senate, we will have to leave it to the Senate.

The PRESIDENT. Is there any objection to the amendment as amended by the gentleman from Quezon? (Silence.) The Chair hears none. The amendment is approved.

Senator SUMÚLONG. Mr. President, for another amendment on page 15, line 17, instead of "contract" it should be "contact". This is a mere misspelling.

The PRESIDENT. Is there any objection? (Silence.) The Chair hears none. The amendment is approved.

Senator SUMÚLONG. Mr. President, for another amendment; on line 18 of page 15, strike out the period (.) after the word "optometrist" and add the following words: "OR OF A PERSON EXEMPTED FROM REGISTRATION UNDER THIS ACT."

The PRESIDENT. Is there any objection? (Silence.) The Chair hears none. The amendment is approved.

Senator SUMÚLONG. Mr. President, if there are no further amendments, I move that we vote on this bill on second reading, as amended.
