

The Chair hears none. The amendment is approved.

Senator SABIDO. In section 9 which, according to the amendment of the Committee has become Section 10, line 26, after the words "out of", insert the following: "THE FIFTY PER CENT OF ITS REVENUES."

ENMIENDA DEL COMITÉ A LA ENMIENDA

Senator CEA. The amendment of the gentleman from Albay, refers only to the fifty per cent share out of the taxes to be paid by the passengers. The amendment will not include the collection out of licenses. The Committee proposes an amendment to the amendment. The amendment should read as follows: on page 3, line 26, after the word "revenues" add the following: "as provided for in sections 5 and 6 above."

Senator SABIDO. I have no objection to the amendment.

The PRESIDENT. Is there any objection to the amendment as amended? (*Silence.*) The Chair hears none. The amendment is approved.

Senator SABIDO. Fourth amendment, Mr. President. Between sections 9 and 10 which according to the amendment of the Committee had become sections 10 and 11, insert a new provision which shall be section 10 and which shall read as follows: "SEC. 10. The Board of Travel and Tourist Industry shall, five days before the opening of the regular sessions of Congress submit to Congress a verified detailed report of its collections, disbursements, and activities, including those of the Philippine Tourist and Travel Association, Inc. and its accomplishments, and a copy of the 'plantilla' as of December 31st of the year immediately preceding."

Senator CEA. That is a good amendment. I accept it.

The PRESIDENT. Is there any objection? (*Silence.*) The Chair hears none. The amendment is approved.

Senator SABIDO. Now I yield the floor to the gentleman from Camarines Sur so that he may ask for the approval of the bill as amended.

Senator CEA. Mr. President, I ask that we approve the bill on second reading, as amended.

Senator CEA. Mr. President, we are now in the period of amendments. The distinguished gentleman from Quezon, Senator Tañada, desires to introduce an amendment here in line with his questioning the other day, that the official who should have the discretion of changing the percentage in the imports authorized by this law should not be the President but another official who may be appointed in court for non-compliance with the provisions of this law. I have no objection to this kind of amendment.

Senator TAÑADA. Mr. President.

The PRESIDENT. Gentleman from Quezon.

Senator TAÑADA. That official who will take the place of the President of the Philippines should be the Secretary of Commerce and Industry.

Senator CEA. I have no objection. Anyway the law is being implemented by the Department of Commerce and Industry.

Senator CEA. Mr. President, for clarification only, just to pin-point the lines and the page where the amendment should appear. On line 10, page 20, strike out the words "President of the Philippines" and in lieu thereof insert the following: "Secretary of Commerce and Industry."
