CREATING CERTAIN BARRIOS IN THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF PATNOÑGON

Mr. MONTANO. Mr. Speaker, I ask that we consider now House Bill No. 1182.

The SPEAKER. The consideration of House Bill No. 1182 is now in order. With the permission of the House, the Secretary will read only the title of the bill, without prejudice to inserting in the Record the whole text thereof.

The SECRETARY, *reading*:

An Act creating certain barrios in the Municipality of Patnoñgon, Province of Antique.

(*The following is the whole text of the bill.*)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to create certain barrios in the Municipality of Patnoñgon, Province of Antique.

This bill is in response to the popular and enthusiastic clamor of the inhabitants of the proposed barrios. Each of the proposed barrios embraces a large geographic area, has a sufficient number of inhabitants, and is very progressive. The enactment of this bill will bring the blessings of good government to the residents therein. It is in accordance with the rural development program of the Administration to improve and ameliorate the living condition of the people. It will enable the people of the proposed barrios to participate actively in their barrio affairs and help in the development and uplift of the Municipality of Patnoñgon.

In view of the foregoing, approval of this bill is earnestly recommended.

AN ACT CREATING CERTAIN BARRIOS IN THE  
MUNICIPALITY OF PATNOÑGON, PROVINCE OF  
ANTIQUÉ.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. The following sitios in the Municipality of Patnoñgon, Province of Antique, are constituted as distinct and independent barrios, to wit:

1. The sitios of Magranging, Tigangcal, Agsaman, Epgas, Epayo and Eglapang, to be known as the barrio of Alvañiz;
2. The sitios of Igtuba Maradona and Igtuba Aureliana, to be known as the barrio of Magsaysay;
3. The sitios of Amarong, Tagbacan, Da-o, Yapo and Embalodan, to be known as the barrio of Elio; and
4. The sitios of Tigabobo, Tiglomabong, Maybangel, Calagtiñgan and Bongboñgan, to be known as the barrio of Vista Alegre.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Mr. MONTANO. Mr. Speaker, I move that the bill be approved.

CONVERTING CERTAIN SITIOS IN THE MUNICIPALITY  
OF SALCEDO INTO BARRIOS

The SECRETARY, *reading*:

An Act converting the sitios of Siguinon, Lusod, Cantomoha, Hagnaya and Karapdapan in the Municipality of Salcedo, Province of Samar, to barrios, to be known as the barrios of Siguinon, Lusod, Cantomoha, Hagnaya and Karapdapan, respectively.

(*The following is the whole text of the bill.*)

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert the sitios of Siguinon, Lusod, Cantomoha, Hagnaya and Karapdapan in the Municipality of Salcedo, Province of Samar, into barrios of said municipality, to be known as the barrios of Siguinon, Lusod, Cantomoha, Hagnaya and Karapdapan, respectively.

This bill is in response to the unanimous wish of the residents of the proposed barrios. Each of the proposed barrios of Siguinon, Lusod, Cantomoha, Hagnaya and Karapdapan has a sufficient number of inhabitants, embraces a large geographic area, and is progressive. The conversion of the said sitios into barrios is a forward step to bring the blessings of good government to the residents. This bill is in line with the rural development program of the Administration to ameliorate the living condition of the people. Therefore, as a consummate fulfillment of this unanimous clamor and enthusiastic demand of the inhabitants of the proposed barrios and in order to give them a chance to manage their barrio affairs and help in the progress and uplift of the Municipality of Salcedo, approval of this bill is earnestly recommended.

AN ACT CONVERTING THE SITIOS OF SIGUINON,  
LUNSOD, CANTAMOHA, HAGNAYA AND KARAP-  
DAPAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SALCEDO,  
PROVINCE OF SAMAR, TO BARRIOS, TO BE
