### AN ACT

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# STRENGTHENING THE GOVERNANCE AND DEFINING THE SCOPE OF THE PHILIPPINE SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL (PSHS) SYSTEM, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8496

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. A second paragraph is hereby added under Section 2 of

2 Republic Act No. 8496, otherwise known as the Philippine Science High School

- 3 (PSHS) Sytem Act of 1997, to read as follows:
- "THE STATE SHALL ALSO ENSURE THAT EVERY REGION IS 4 OPPORTUNITY TO BENEFIT GIVEN EQUAL FROM THE 5 ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PSHS SYSTEM. TOWARDS THIS END, 6 ONLY ONE (1) PSHS CAMPUS SHALL BE ESTABLISHED IN EACH 7 OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE REGIONS OF THE COUNTRY." 8

9 Sec. 2. Section 3, paragraph (a) of the same Act is hereby amended to
10 read as follows:

"(a) Integrate the existing PSHS at Diliman, NUEVA VIZCAYA,
 CAMARINES SUR, ILOILO CITY, LEYTE, LANAO DEL NORTE AND
 DAVAO CITY [Eastern Visayas, Western Visayas and Mindanao] into one
 system of governance and management;"

15 Sec. 3. Section 5 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 5. Scope. – The Philippine Science High School System
 shall be composed of the existing PSHS campuses HEREIN MENTIONED
 [at Diliman, Eastern Visayas, Western Visayas and Mindanao,] and future

campuses which shall be established under this [law] ACT. THE 1 EXISTING CAMPUSES AT DILIMAN, QUEZON CITY; BAYOMBONG, 2 NUEVA VIZCAYA; GOA, CAMARINES SUR; JARO, ILOILO CITY; 3 PALO, LEYTE; TUGBOK, DAVAO CITY; AND BALO-I, LANAO DEL 4 NORTE, SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE PSHS MAIN CAMPUS, PSHS 5 CAGAYAN VALLEY. PSHS BICOL REGION, PSHS WESTERN 6 VISAYAS, PSHS EASTERN VISAYAS, PSHS SOUTHERN MINDANAO 7 AND PSHS CENTRAL MINDANAO, RESPECTIVELY. 8

9 THE NUEVA VISCAYA SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL, 10 ESTABLISHED UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7622, AS AMENDED BY 11 REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8364, IS HEREBY ABSORBED BY THE PSHS 12 SYSTEM AND SHALL BECOME PSHS CAGAYAN VALLEY CAMPUS.

THE PSHS BICOL CAMPUS LOCATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY 13 OF GOA, CAMARINES SUR, ESTABLISHED UNDER REPUBLIC ACT 14 NO. 8304. AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8619, SHALL BE 15 CONSIDERED DISTINCT AND SEPARATE FROM THE SAN RAFAEL 16 NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TIGAON, 17 CAMARINES SUR. THE SAN RAFAEL NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL 18 SHALL CONTINUE TO EXIST UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE 19 DECS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF BATAS PAMBANSA 20 BLG. 580, AS AMENDED, AND SHALL MAINTAIN ALL PERSONNEL, 21 ASSETS. LIABILITIES AND RECORDS PREVIOUSLY TRANSFERRED 22 AND ABSORBED BY THE PSHS BICOL CAMPUS." 23

Sec. 4. A new Section 6 is hereby inserted between Sections 5 and 6 of
the same Act, to read as follows:

26 "SEC. 6. RESTRICTION ON THE CONVERSION OF HIGH 27 SCHOOLS INTO A PHILIPPINE SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL. - IN 28 ADDITION TO THE GUIDELINES/CRITERIA THAT MAY BE 29 ESTABLISHED BY THE PSHS BOARD OF TRUSTEES IN THE

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ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL,
 THE CONVERSION AND INCLUSION OF EXISTING HIGH SCHOOLS
 INTO THE PSHS SYSTEM SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED."

**Sec. 5.** Section 6 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as follows:

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Sec. [6] 7. Overall Coordinating Authority. – The PSHS System
shall be under the administrative supervision of the Department of Science
and Technology (DOST). THE PSHS SYSTEM BOARD OF TRUSTEES
(BOT) SHALL BE THE GOVERNING BOARD OF ALL THE PSHS
CAMPUSES WHEREVER SITUATED.

10 Sec. 6. Section 7 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. [7] 8. Board of Trustees. - There shall be a Board of 11 Trustees composed of the secretary of the DOST as *ex-officio* Chairman, 12 the secretary of DECS as ex-officio Vice Chairman, and the following 13 members: The President of the U.P., the Executive Director of PSHS, the 14 Director of the Science Education Institute (SEI), [and] the President from 15 the PSHS National Alumni Association, AND THE CHAIRPERSONS OF 16 CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES ON SCIENCE 17 THE AND **TECHNOLOGY** as *ex-officio* members; and one (1) representative each 18 19 from the private sector representing higher education, education for the 20 gifted, industry, agriculture, and new and emerging technologies. The private sector representatives shall be appointed by [the Chairman subject 21 to the confirmation of the Board of Trustees UPON RECOMMENDATION 22 23 OF A DULY CONSTITUTED SEARCH COMMITTEE. For the first set of appointments, three (3) of them shall serve for four (4) years, while the 24 other two (2) for two (2) years, thereafter, succeeding appointments shall 25 26 have a fixed term of four (4) years.

27 The Board shall exercise the following powers:

(a) Formulate policies and guidelines for the administration and
 operation of the PSHS System;

(B) FIX THE SITE OF THE PSHS CAMPUS IN EACH OF THE 1 **ADMINISTRATIVE REGIONS;** 2 (C)[b] [Formulate policies on the] APPROVE appointment, 3 retention, [removal,] renewal, rewards 4 promotion, and incentives for [administrators,] faculty and staff, FIX THEIR 5 6 COMPENSATION AND OTHER **CONDITIONS** OF EMPLOYMENT, AND REMOVE THEM FOR CAUSE AFTER 7 **PROPER INVESTIGATION AND HEARING:** 8 9 (D)[c] Approve the curricula submitted by the Executive Director; (E)[d] Approve the criteria for the selection and admission of 10 11 students; (F)[e] Approve the grant of scholarship, stipend and such 12 13 allowances for students: 14 (G)[f] Approve the graduation of successful candidates from the various PSHS campuses; 15 (H)[g] Formulate policies and rules of discipline for students, faculty 16 17 and staff; (I)[h] Approve the PSHS System budget, RECEIVE and 18 appropriate to the ends specified by law such sums as may be 19 20 provided by law for the support of the System; (J)[i] Receive grants whether cash, land, 21 buildings and improvements thereof; donations, contributions, bequest, gifts, 22 23 and to formulate policies for the administration thereof; (K)APPROVE THE USE OF ALL INCOME GENERATED BY THE 24 SCHOOL IN THE PURSUIT OF ITS FUNCTION AND 25 DONATIONS **RECEIVED IN** 26 TRUST BY **INDIVIDUAL** CAMPUSES, ACCORDING TO THE PURPOSE OF THE GAIN 27 AND INTENTION OF THE DONATION. IN CASES WHERE 28 INCOME/DONATION RECEIVED IS NOT INTENDED FOR A 29

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PARTICULAR CAMPUS, THE BOARD SHALL LIKEWISE APPROPRIATE THE SAME FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SYSTEM OR ANY PART THEREOF;

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- 4 (L)[j] Develop policies for the expansion of enrollment in the
   5 campuses under the PSHS System;
- 6 (M)[k] [Set] ESTABLISH policies and FORMULATE 7 GUIDELINES/criteria, REQUIREMENTS **NECESSARY** to rationalize the establishment AND OPERATION of the science 8 9 high schools under the System IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THE QUALITY AND UNIFORM STANDARD INHERENT OF A 10 BONAFIDE PSHS [, for its evaluation and approval thereof]; 11 12 and
- (N)[I] Prepare strategic plans to enhance the capability of the
  System in developing human resources with focus on youth with
  special talents in science and mathematics."

16 Sec. 7. Section 8 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. [8] 9. Executive Director (ED). - There shall be an 17 18 Executive Director who shall be appointed by [the Chairman, subject to 19 the approval of] the Board and shall be conferred the rank equivalent to a 20 bureau director with a fixed term of six (6) years, renewable for another term. The ED shall [coordinate the implementation] EXERCISE 21 ADMINISTRATIVE SUPERVISION OVER ALL CAMPUS DIRECTORS 22 AND SHALL BE THE PRIMARY IMPLEMENTOR 23 of policies and 24 guidelines set by the Board of Trustees. As a member of the Board of 25 Trustees, the ED shall articulate to the Board the mutual concern of all the 26 campuses."

Sec. 8. A new Section 10 is hereby inserted between Sections 8 and 9 of
the same Act, to read as follows;

"SEC. 10. - DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR (DED). THERE
 SHALL BE A DEPUTY EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR (DED) WHO SHALL BE
 APPOINTED BY THE BOARD FOR A TERM OF SIX (6) YEARS,
 RENEWABLE FOR ANOTHER TERM. THE DED SHALL PERFORM
 THE DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS ASSIGNED BY THE EXECUTIVE
 DIRECTOR."

7 Sec. 9. Section 9 of the same Act is hereby renumbered as Section 11.

8 **Sec. 10.** Section 10 of the same Act shall be amended, to read as follows:

9 "Sec. [10] 12. Executive Committee. – There shall be an
10 Executive Committee IN THE PSHS SYSTEM composed of the Executive
11 Director AS EX-OFFICIO CHAIRPERSON and the Campus Directors [in
12 the PSHS System] as members. [The committee shall be collegial in
13 character.]

Sec. 11. Sections 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 of the same Act are hereby
renumbered accordingly.

Sec. 12. Repealing and Amending Clause. - All laws, executive orders,
 presidential decrees, rules and regulations or parts hereof which are inconsistent
 with any provision of this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

Sec. 13. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect immediately upon its
 approval.
