AN ACT STRENGTHENING THE GOVERNANCE AND DEFINING THE SCOPE OF THE PHILIPPINE SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL (PSHS) SYSTEM, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8496

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. A second paragraph is hereby added under Section
2	2 of Republic Act No. 8496, otherwise known as the Philippine Science
3	High School (PSHS) Sytem Act of 1997, to read as follows:
4	"THE STATE SHALL ALSO ENSURE THAT EVERY
5	REGION IS GIVEN EQUAL OPPORTUNITY TO BENEFIT
6	FROM THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE PSHS SYSTEM.
7	TOWARDS THIS END, ONLY ONE (1) PSHS CAMPUS SHALL
8	BE ESTABLISHED IN EACH OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE
9	REGIONS OF THE COUNTRY."
0	SEC. 2. Section 3, paragraph (a) of the same Act is hereby

2	"(a) Integrate the existing PSHS at Diliman, NUEVA

5	Executive Director AS EX-OFFICIO CHAIRPERSON and the
6	Campus Directors [in the PSHS System] as members. [The
7	committee shall be collegial in character.]"
8	SEC. 11. Sections 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15 of the same Act are hereby
9	renumbered accordingly.
10	SEC. 12. Repealing and Amending Clause All laws, executive
11	orders, presidential decrees, rules and regulations or parts hereof which
12	are inconsistent with any provision of this Act are hereby repealed or
13	amended accordingly.
14	SEC. 13. Effectivity This Act shall take effect immediately upon
15	its approval.
